

## Harbour City Photography Club

### Rules for Print Competition

1. Members may only enter their own photographs.
2. Images submitted to Club competitions must not have been entered in previous Club competitions.
3. Up to 4 prints may be entered in each competition – 1 colour (which includes monochrome prints that have been coloured in whole or in part), 1 monochrome (B&W, sepia, brown-toned, gold etc.), 1 theme (either black and white or colour) , and 1 manipulated (digitally manipulated beyond standard cropping, colour adjustments, etc.)
4. Entries shall be on mat or backing that is:  
8" or larger in the smallest dimension,  
20" or smaller in the largest dimension,  
Stiff,  
At most single matted,  
Unframed, no glass  
Free of bulky or heavy materials such as particleboard or wood,  
Free of identifying marks on the front,  
Marked on the rear with the member's name and the print's title  
And an arrow indicating up.
5. If you are unable to submit entries at the meeting listed in the program, it is your responsibility to arrange to deliver prints to the print chair before Friday of that week.
6. The club does not take financial responsibility for prints damaged or lost in competition.
7. Prints submitted for competition may be printed in the newsletter or displayed on our web page unless the print is accompanied by written documentation denying publication.
8. Scores will be tabulated at year's end for our awards night.
9. Judge's opinions are final.
